

Roadside Assistance within RSA Borders

Breakdown Incident	Benefit
Mechanical and electrical breakdown.	Emergency roadside repairs or a tow-in service provided. If the vehicle cannot be repaired in location, it will be towed to the nearest place for repair or to the nearest place of safe storage.
Flat Tyre	Cost of tyre change
Vehicle running out of fuel	10 litres of fuel supplied
Flat battery	A battery recharge
Keys locked inside vehicle	Locksmith's call-out fee and first hour's Labour

In the event of a mechanical and/or electrical breakdown, which occurs more than 100km from the policyholder's place of residence:

Emergency roadside repairs or a tow-in service provided. If the vehicle cannot be repaired on location, the vehicle will be towed to an appropriate service provider in the area

AND

One night's accommodation (maximum value R500);

OR

Rental of a class B vehicle for one day (subject to a 200km limit);

AND

Repatriation cost of a repaired vehicle, subject to the cost of a vehicle rental limit of 200km.

Exclusions

- Commercial vehicles
- Cost of repairs of parts, or replacements such as battery, tyre/s, locks and keys
- Cost of accident/collisions tow-ins
- Cost of repairs of locks and/or ignition as a result of attempted theft
- Cost of locksmith in the event of keys lost and not locked inside
- Cost of assistance not arranged by call centre operator
- Cost of assistance outside RSA borders
